1. The petitioner has filed this petition seeking the following relief(s):-

"10.1 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue an appropriate writ.



10.2 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to call for the record.

10.3 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondent authority to amend the promotion list of Annexure P/1 and P/2 promoted the petitioner.

10.4 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondent authority to again the investigation in the promotion list that why the junior respondent no. 5 and 6 is promoted but the petitioner is not promoted.

10.5 Any other relief which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper may also be passed in favour of the petitioner together with cost of petition."

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has claimed promotion to the post of Assistant Grade-II with effect from 14.11.2019 when his juniors were promoted to the said post.
3. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No. 1 to 5 would submit that the petitioner has already been promoted to the post of Assistant Grade-II vide order dated 23.11.2021 and order has been placed on record as Annexure- R/1.
4. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
5. Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has already been promoted to the post of Assistant Grade-II, there is no need to keep this matter pending. Accordingly, this petition is **disposed of** as the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed. With regard to seniority, the petitioner would be at liberty to make a representation before the respondent authorities. If such a representation is made by the petitioner, it is expected that the respondent Authorities shall consider it in objective manner expeditiously.
