SHIVSHAKTI WOMEN SELF HELP - KIRNA **versus** STATE OF CHHATTISGARH

13/04/2026	Mr. A. N. Pandey, counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Soumitra Kesharwani, Panel Lawyer for the State/respondent Nos.1 to 4. Heard. Issue notice to the respondents by both modes. Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4, hence issuance of notice to them is dispensed with. Process fee be paid within a week only for respondent No.5. Also heard on I.A. No.01/2026, application for grant of interim relief. Issue notice to the respondents on this application also, as above. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in view of show cause notice dated 06.03.2026 (Annexure P-4), the impugned order dated 17.03.2026 (Annexure P-1)

has been passed by respondent No.3, whereby the allotment of the petitioner's fair price shop has been suspended and attached to respondent No.5. He further submits that, while passing the impugned order, the explanation (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner has not been considered. Hence, learned counsel prays that effect and operation of the impugned order (Annexure P-1) may be stayed.

In reply, learned counsel for the State/Respondent Nos.1 to 4 submits that, after considering the reply filed by the petitioner, the same was not found satisfactory, therefore, the allotment of the petitioner's fair price shop has been suspended, hence, interim protection may not be granted to the petitioner.

On due consideration, I am not inclined to grant interim protection to the petitioner, hence, the prayer is rejected, and I.A. No.01/2026 stands dismissed.

Two weeks' time is granted to learned counsel for the respondents to file their reply.

List the case after two weeks.
