03/08/2026	Ms. Swati Agrawal, counsel for the appellant. Mr. Satish Surya, counsel for respondents No.1 to 4. None for respondent No.6. Heard on I.A. No.02/2026, for deleting the name of respondent No.5, Fulmat Bai. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that respondent No.5, Fulmat Bai, the mother of the deceased, has expired and that her legal representatives are already on record as respondents No.1 to 4. It is further submitted that the application is supported by an affidavit. Accordingly, a prayer has been made to delete the name of respondent No.5 from the array of respondents. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.1 to 4 has no objection to the said prayer. In view of the aforesaid, I.A. No.02/2026 is allowed. Let the necessary amendment/deletion be carried out in the cause title within 7 working days.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant–Insurance Company has confined the present appeal only to the quantum of compensation awarded by the Tribunal and has not questioned the finding with regard to liability. It is, therefore, submitted that the service of notice to respondent No.7, the owner of the offending vehicle, is not necessary, and an oral prayer has been made for dispensing with the service of notice to the said respondent.

The oral prayer made on behalf of the appellant is allowed, and notice to respondent No.7 stands dispensed with.

List this case for final hearing in the week commencing 24th August, 2026.
