04/05/2026	<p>Mr. Bhaskar Payashi, Advocate along with Mr. Jitendra Singh Rajput, counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>Mr. S. S. Choubey, G.A. for the State.</p> <p>Vide order dated 27.4.2026, the State counsel was directed to seek instruction in this matter.</p> <p>Accordingly, when the matter is taken up today, learned counsel for the State submits, upon instructions, that he has obtained certain documents which are required to be placed on record and proposes to file the same along with the reply; in view thereof, he prays for a period of four weeks' time to file the reply.</p>

Learned counsel for the respondents are directed to ensure that the crops sown by the petitioner are not destroyed, and the petitioner shall be permitted to harvest the same; however, so far as any further relief is concerned, no order can be passed at this stage.

Learned counsel for the State prays for and is granted four weeks' time to file return. Thereafter, two weeks further time is granted to the petitioner to file rejoinder.
