

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****MCRC No. 3594 of 2026**Akash Gupta **Versus** State of Chhattisgarh**Order Sheet**

21/04/2026	Heard Mr. Raghvendra Pradhan, learned counsel for the applicant. Also heard Mr. Sourabh Sahu, learned Panel Lawyer appearing for the Non-applicant/State. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in paragraph 4(a) of the present bail application, the copy served upon the Office of the Advocate General reflects that the applicant has four criminal antecedents. However, learned counsel for the applicant submits that paragraph 4(a) was subsequently corrected at the time of filing before the Registry to indicate that the applicant has no criminal antecedents. This Court observes that carrying out such corrections in the bail application after service of its copy upon the Office of the Advocate General is not a proper



practice.

Accordingly, let the matter be listed again after two weeks along with MCRC No. 2945 of 2026. In the meantime, learned counsel for the applicant shall supply a fresh and corrected copy of the bail application to the Office of the Advocate General.
