1. Heard.
2. By way of this petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs :

10.1 That this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction directing Respondent Nos. 3 and 4 to forthwith transmit the complete original records of Revenue Appeal No. 5/A-6/1992-93 order passed on dated 11.03.1993, parties "Harnam Singh & 7 others Vs. Peter Adward & 1 other" and Revenue Case No. 26/A-6/1991-92 order passed on dated 03.09.1992, parties "Harnam Singh & 7 others Vs. Peter Adward & 1 other", respectively to the Board of Revenue, Bilaspur, District Bilaspur (C.G.) in Revenue Case No. R-352/A-6/2003-04 within a stipulated time-bound period.

10.2) That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct Respondent No. 2 i.e., Board of Revenue, Bilaspur, District Bilaspur (C.G.) to decide the pending Revenue Case No. R-352/A- 6/2003-04 expeditiously within a fixed time frame.

10.3) That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to pass any other order(s) as may be deemed fit, in the interest of justice.

3. Learned counsel for the State submits that the records of the Naib Tehsildar, Pendra Road was requisitioned on several occasions, however, they have not been furnished. Lastly, on 28.4.2025, it was reported that the records have been lost. As such, the case which is pending before the concerned Commissioner has remained undecided. He further submits that in view of the missing records, the Board of Revenue shall now decide the



matter on the basis of the documents filed by the petitioner and those currently available with the Board.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the Board of Revenue be directed to decide the matter within a specified time frame.
5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly considering the fact that the matter has been pending since 2003-2004, the Board of Revenue is directed to decide the subject case expeditiously, preferably within a period of two months, notwithstanding the unavailability of the original records. The Board shall settle the matter using the documents currently on record and any copies provided, since the original records are unavailable.
6. With the aforesaid observations/directions, the Petition is disposed of.
