23/04/2026	Mr. A. N. Bhakta, Advocate and Mr. Vivek Bhakta, Advocate for the petitioner. Mr. Anadi Sharma, P. L. for the State. Heard. Issue notice to respondents. Mr. Sharma accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 4, hence, no process fee is required to be paid for issuance of notice to respondents No. 1 to 4. On payment of process fee, issue notice to respondent No. 5 through usual as also through speed post.

Also heard on I.A. No. 01 of 2026, an application for grant of ad interim relief / stay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in an earlier round of litigation, vide order dated 16.02.2024, the Tahsildar, Pithora had dismissed the application filed under Section 250 of the Chhattisgarh Land Revenue Code, 1959, observing that as per the report on record, a house had been constructed upon the subject land and, therefore, the Tahsildar lacked the power and authority to pass an order under Section 250 of the Code of 1959. It is further submitted that, thereafter, a subsequent order dated 06.04.2026 has been passed by the same authority, purportedly overlooking the earlier order. In the said order, it has been observed that no direction is being issued with respect to the portion of land upon which the house stands constructed; however, in respect of the remaining vacant land, proceedings under Section 250 of the Code of 1959 are maintainable, and accordingly, appropriate orders have been passed.

<i>Shayna</i>	On due consideration, it is directed that impugned eviction / dispossession notice date 06.04.2026 passed by the Tahsildar, Pithora, shall remain stayed till next date of hearing. List this matter after receipt of service report. Sd/- (Amitendra Kishore Prasad) Judge
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
