2. Mr. Dharmesh Shrivastava, learned Deputy Advocate General, appeared for the respondents/State along with Dr. Goverdhan Yadu, Assistant Director, Department of Higher Education, Indravati Bhawan, Nava Raipur.
3. Mrs. Vinita Dwivedi, wife of petitioner No.1 (late Dilip Dwivedi), submits that her husband expired on 23.03.2023.
