23/04/2026	Shri Ashok Soni, counsel for the petitioner. Ms. Isha Jajodiya, PL for the State/respondent No.3. Heard. Issue notice to the respondents No.1 and 2 on payment of PF as per rules. Also heard on I.A. No. 01/2026, which is an application for grant of interim relief. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the suit, the petitioner/plaintiff has been dispossessed from the suit land by the defendants. Consequently an application for amendment of the plaint was preferred however, the same has been rejected by the learned trial court on the ground that such amendment would alter the nature of the suit. He further submits that earlier the petitioner/plaintiff has filed the suit for mandatory injunction and during its pendency, having been dispossessed, the petitioner is now

seeking to incorporate a relief for recovery of possession of the suit land by way of amendment.

Considering the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that further proceedings in Civil Suit No. 55A/2023 pending before the learned Second Civil Judge, Senior Division, Pendra Road shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.

It is made clear that in the event the petitioner fail to pay PF to the respondents No.1 and 2, the interim order shall automatically lose its efficacy without further reference to the Bench.

List this case immediately after service of notice upon the respondent No.1 and 2.
