Learned counsel for the petitioner respectfully submits that the retiral dues owed to the petitioner have not been disbursed in a full and final manner as required. Specifically, the petitioner has not been receiving the complete pension amount to which they are entitled; instead, only 90% of the pension amount is being paid. This shortfall has caused significant financial hardship and grievance to the petitioner, thereby necessitating the filing of the present petition to



	seek appropriate relief and ensure that the petitioner's retiral benefits, including the full pension, are duly and promptly paid in accordance with the applicable rules and entitlements. On the other hand, learned counsel for the State submits that due to some irregularity was found in the tenure of the petitioner as such D.E. is going on. He further submits that he may be given some time to seek instruction and to file appropriate reply in this matter. Accordingly, list this case in the week commencing 27th October, 2025.
