**“RELIEF SOUGHT:**

10.1 That, this Hon'ble High Court may kindly be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents, particularly Respondent No.3, to release/issue the Transfer Certificate of petitioner's minor daughter Prisha Banjare.

10.2 That, this Hon'ble High Court may kindly be further pleased to direct Respondent No.2 to ensure compliance of the aforesaid direction within a time bound manner.

10.3 That any other relief/order which may deem fit and just in the facts and circumstances of the case including award of the cost of the petition may be given.”

2. Considering facts of the case, nature of reliefs, submissions of counsel for the respective parties, respondent No.3/Principal is directed to comply the order/communication dated 23.03.2026, whereby respondent No.2/District Education Officer has directed to issue the transfer certificate (TC) in respect of minor Prisha Banjare (daughter of petitioner) and to furnish the compliance report before the Registrar Judicial of this Court on or before 04th May 2026.
3. With the aforesaid direction, the instant petition stands disposed of.
