Learned counsel for petitioner submits that without issuing any notice or giving opportunity of hearing, respondent-department has started deduction of sum of Rs.7,885/- from salary of petitioner stating that excess payment has been made to him, which is arbitrary and illegal. Considering facts of the case, above submission of counsel for the petitioner, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that no further recovery shall be made from salary of petitioner till the next date of hearing.
