03/12/2025	Mr. Avinash Chand Sahu, and Mr. Aman Tamrakar appeared through virtual mode, learned counsel for the appellant. Mr. Sanjay Agrawal, learned counsel for the Respondent No. 1 to 7. Mr. Neeraj Sharma, learned Dy. Advocate General, appearing for the State/Respondent No.8. Learned counsel for the appellant would submit that though there is no any decree for possession in favour of the Respondents, yet they are prosecuting an execution case in which the learned trial Court has issued the possession warrant of the suit property against the appellant, therefore, the further proceeding of the learned executing Court may be stayed. On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the Respondents opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the appellant.



Considering the nature of dispute between the parties, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that the parties shall maintain status quo over the suit property as obtained today till the next day of hearing.

It is made clear that the parties shall make their submission on the next date of hearing on the admission of the appeal.
