08/05/2026	Shri KP Sahu, Advocate for the petitioners. Shri Priyank Rathi, Govt. Advocate for the State/respondents No.1 to 3. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that marriage between the complainant/respondent No.4 and petitioner no.4 was solemnized as per their rites and rituals. After sometime of marriage some dispute arose between the parties leading to file complaint against petitioners for the offence under Sections 85 and
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3(5) of BNS vide Crime No.51/2025 by the concerned police and thereafter Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bemetara, initiated a criminal proceeding in Criminal Case No.6248 of 2025. He further submitted that the present matter be referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court being matrimonial in nature as there are chances to compromise between the parties.

Considering the fact that the dispute between the parties is matrimonial in nature, we deem it appropriate to make an effort to get the said dispute settled by way of mediation.

In view of the above, petitioner-4/husband shall deposit Rs.50,000/- with the Mediation Centre of this Court within a period of one week from today and the same shall be paid to respondent No. 4/wife on her appearance before the Mediation Centre.

Parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on 20.05.2026.

Learned State counsel is directed to inform the private respondent i.e. respondent No. 4 about passing of this order, so that she may appear before the Mediation Centre on the aforesaid date.

List this matter along with report of Mediation Centre before this Court on 22.06.2026.

Till the next date of listing, the further proceedings of Criminal Case No.6248 of 2025 pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bemetara, District-Bemetara (C.G.), against the petitioners, shall remain stayed.

It is made clear that in case the aforesaid amount is

not deposited within the aforesaid period, the interim protection granted as above shall automatically be vacated and this petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to this Bench.

The petitioners are directed to produce copy of the receipt before the concerned trial Court regarding payment of the said money before the Mediation Centre of this Court in pursuance of this Court's order, then only this order shall be given into effect.

It is also made clear that if any final settlement is arrived at between the parties, the aforesaid amount so deposited, shall be adjusted.
