2. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following reliefs:

"10.1 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue the writ of mandamus commanding upon the respondents no. 1 to 4 and direct them to arrest the respondent no. 5 immediately for the crime registered in police station Malkharoda Distt. Sakti (CG) in FIR no. 120/2026, in the interest of Justice.

10.2 That, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to call for the entire relevant records from the respondents.

10.3 That, Any other order of orders or Direction or Relief though just and fit in the circumstances of the case may also kindly be granted."

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that, during the pendency of the present writ petition, the relief sought in paragraph

10.1 has become infructuous, as the petitioner has already been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 23.04.2026 passed in MCRCA No. 554/2026.

4. In view of the above, this petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
