08/05/2026	Mr. Aman Pandey, Counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Arham Siddiqui, P.L. for the State. Issue notice to the respondents on payment of P.F. Mr. Arham Siddiqui accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 1-4. Hence, P.F. is not required to be paid. Issue notice to respondent no. 5-11 on payment of P.F, within 7 working days, through ordinary as well as Speed Post. Also, heard on I.A. No. 01/2026, application for grant of interim relief. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a lease agreement dated 02.06.2025 were executed by Respondent no. 8, being the Sarpanch of Respondent No. 5/Gram Panchayat, in favour of respondents no. 9, 10 & 11 without cancelling the earlier lease agreement dated 05.10.2024

executed in favour of the petitioners by convening a Gram Sabha meeting. He has also filed an application stating that he is in possession of the property as such interim protection may be granted.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that on the basis of valid agreement dated 05.10.2024, the petitioner is in possession of the property in dispute which has not been expired and thereafter during pendency, subsequent agreement dated 02.06.2025 has been executed by respondent no. 8 in favour of respondent no. 9 to 11.

In view of above, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that effect and operation of the lease agreement dated 02.06.2025 executed in favour of respondent no. 9 to 11 shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing only.

Accordingly, I.A. No. 01/2026 is hereby allowed.
