29.06.2026	Heard Mr. Bishnu Muni, learned counsel for the appellant. Also heard Ms. Vaishali Mahilong, learned Deputy Government Advocate, appearing for the State/respondent. I.A. No. 02/2026 is an application for condonation of delay preferred by appellant as the appeal is barred by 16 days. Since the learned State counsel has no objection if delay in filing the appeal is condoned as the accused has statutory right to file an appeal, we condone the delay in filing the present appeal. Admit. Since Ms. Vaishali Mahilong, learned Deputy Government Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the State/respondent, there is no need to issue fresh notice to the respondent.

Learned State Counsel is directed to inform the complainant / mother of the victim (PW-5) regarding pendency of the appeal as well as an application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail to the appellant revealing that she can appear on the date fixed and object the prayer in bail application through her counsel.

The State may file its reply/objection to I.A. No. 01 of 2026, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail within a period of two weeks.

Summon the Trial Court Record within six weeks.

Let the paper-book be filed in accordance with the High Court Rules, 2007.

List the matter thereafter for consideration on I.A. No.1 of 2026, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail.

Defaults pointed out by the Registry is overruled.
