No. 01/2023 which is an application for condonation of delay in filing of this criminal revision. This revision is filed against the order dated 13.01.2023 in MJC No. 961/2017 whereby, the learned Family Court has partly allowed the application filed by the Respondents under Section 125 of Cr.P.C. The submissions made by counsel for the applicant as also, the pleadings made in the application is opposed by the counsel for the respondent stating that proper explanation is not offered. Hence, delay could not be condoned.
