1. By way of this petition, the petitioner has prayed for following reliefs:-

"10.1 That this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus, thereby directing Respondent Nos. 2 to 5 to forthwith implement the approved transfer of Respondent No.6 from Kharora Society to Singhanpur Society and handover the charge of Respondent No. 4 Society to Respondent No.6;

10.2 That, any other relief/order which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and just in the facts and circumstances of the case, including award of the costs of the petition, may be given."

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the competent authority by filing an



appropriate representation/application before the concerned Collector for redressal of the grievances raised herein. It is further submitted that the petitioner shall file a comprehensive application along with all relevant documents before the concerned Collector, and, in the event such an application is filed, this Court may be pleased to direct the concerned Collector to consider and decide the same strictly in accordance with law, after affording the petitioner an adequate opportunity of hearing, by passing a reasoned and speaking order, within a reasonable and time-bound period.

3. No objection has been raised from other side.
4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.
5. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty in favour of the petitioner to approach the competent authority by filing an appropriate representation/application before the concerned Collector for redressal of the grievances raised herein, and if such an application is filed before the concerned Collector, the concerned Collector is directed to decide the same in accordance with law within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
