In view of the above, the matters are referred to the Medication Centre. Both the parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on 10/03/2026 for exploring the possibility of amicable settlement.

It is also clarified that the Mediation Centre shall issue notice to all respondents to ensure that they have an opportunity to participate in the mediation process. The Mediation Centre shall proceed only after satisfying itself that proper notice has been served upon all parties in accordance with law.
