Therefore, at the time of filing of the present appeal, the appellant has filed the instant application under Order XXII Rule 4 CPC, in view of the provisions contained in Rule 125 of the High Court of Chhattisgarh Rules, 2007.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 has no objection to the said application.

Despite service of notice to the proposed legal

representatives of respondent No. 2, none appears on their behalf.

Accordingly, I.A. No. 02/2017 is allowed.

The appellant shall carry out necessary amendment in the memo of appeal within a period of ten days.
