27/07/2022	None for the petitioners as the arguing counsel Shri N.K. Malaviya is reported to be indisposed. Mr. Amrito Das, Additional A.G. with Ms. Sunita Jain, Government Advocate for the State. Mr. R.K. Gupta, Advocate for the respondent No.5. In pursuance of the directions passed by this Court on 20.07.2022, the State has filed affidavit indicating details of the amount which has been withdrawn. Along with the affidavit, they have also annexed the list to demonstrate that the persons namely Shri Shyamta Prasad Chaturvdani, Shri Vijay Lal Painkara, Late Kripa Ram Painkara, Late Nathuram Dhruv, Shri Rameshwar Prasad Gaikwad, Shri Chandra Prakash Kurre, Shri Kodan Sav Manhare and Shri Mohan Lal Joshi have minus account of GPF account as per the position prevailing on 2002 & 2003 whereas the amount which is said to have been withdrawn is

varying from Rs.90,000/- to Rs.1,50,000/- which is much less than the amount shown in it credit and debit balance, therefore, the State has shown their inability to do the needful for them and considering this aspect, let the petitioners verify their records and submit before the Accountant General for further verification so that the final dues may be settled.

So far as the other two persons namely Kartik Ram Dhruv and Beer Singh Patel are having positive balance of Rs.1,27,144/- and Rs.2,03,199/- whereas the money which has been fraudulently withdrawn is varying from Rs.85,00,000/- to Rs.90,00,000/- and for that the Joint Director, Public Instructions, Raipur, C.G. has forwarded the case to the State Government for taking approval.

Let the exercise be carried out within four weeks and list these matters on **1st September, 2022**. On that day, the State will come with the positive scheme with regard to the persons whose accounts are having positive balance. So far as the other persons whose accounts have been shown as negative may make a submission before the Accountant General or the Institution where they have worked so that the discrepancy shown in the account may be cured before the next date of hearing.

A copy of the order of this Court be given to the Government

Advocate and the Accountant General so that they may take necessary action.
