Heard on petition and on the application for grant of interim relief. It is submitted that the transfer order dated 20.05.2022 (Annexure-P/1) is under challenge on the ground that it is a case of frequent transfer and, further, the respondent No.3, who has been transferred in the place of the petitioner had earlier filed representation for transfer, but later on she had withdrawn the same, hence, she also does not wish to proceed on transfer as ordered.
