20.01.2026	Mr. Arvind Prasad, counsel for the appellant/s. Ms. Meenakshi Gupta, Advocate holding the brief of Mr. Ashish Gupta, counsel for respondent No.2. Heard on I.A. No.1, an application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal. Mr. Prasad, the learned counsel appearing for the appellants would submit that it is an appeal filed by the claimants and there is delay of 51 days. He would further submit that due to poverty and ignorance, the appellants could not prefer appeal within limitation. He would contend that the appellants have explained the delay part properly. He would pray to condone the delay. On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.2 would oppose the submissions made by Mr. Prasad. Heard.

Having considered the submissions made by Mr. Prasad and the reasons assigned in the application, the same is allowed.
