10.06.2021	Shri Sanjay Patel, counsel for the appellant. Heard on admission. Admit. Issue notice to the respondents, on payment of P.F. within 7 days. Also heard on I.A.No.01/2020, an application for grant of stay. Issue notice of this application also to the respondents, as above. Meanwhile, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that the effect and operation of the impugned award dated 13.02.2020 passed by the Motor Accident



Claims Tribunal, Jashpur in claim case No.21/2019 shall remain stayed, in so far as the present appellant is concerned, till the next date of hearing, subject to appellant's depositing 50% of the award under appeal before the concerned Tribunal/Executing Court within a period of two months from today.

Respondents No.1 to 3/claimants shall be entitled to withdraw the same upon furnishing the requisite security to the satisfaction of the concerned Tribunal/Executing Court.

It is made clear that if any of the conditions is violated, then this interim order shall lose its efficacy and the award impugned shall become executable.

Call for the record of the Claims Tribunal and post this matter after 5 weeks for consideration on I.A.No.01/2020.
