P.F. and copies within in 07 days. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the learned Appellate Court has set aside the sentence imposed upon the applicant under the provisions of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, which had been awarded by the learned Trial Court for a period of six months. However, insofar as the compensation awarded by the Trial Court is concerned, the same has been affirmed by the Appellate Court. It is further submitted that the applicant may be granted some reasonable time to deposit the amount of compensation as directed by the Trial Court and affirmed by the Appellate Court.
