

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****WPC No. 2765 of 2026****RESHAMLAL DIWAKAR *versus* Kishan Kumar Diwakar****Order Sheet**

02/06/2026	Mr. Ankur Diwan, learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Raj Kumar Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General for the State/respondents No. 7 & 8. Heard. Issue notice to respondents on payment of process fee, as per rules, within one week. Learneled Additional Advocate General accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 7 & 8. Hence, issuance of notice to them is dispensed with. P.F. be paid only for respondents No. 1 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have instituted a civil suit on 06.05.2026 before the Court of the First Additional Judge to the Civil Judge, Junior Division, Mungeli, seeking a declaration of title and permanent injunction against respondents No. 1 to 6. It is contended that Late Sitaram, father of respondents No. 1 to 6, had acknowledged in a consent letter (सहमति पत्र) that he had already received his share in the ancestral property and, therefore, the remaining suit land exclusively belongs to the petitioners. Despite the objections raised by the petitioners, the Tehsildar, Pathariya, District Mungeli, entertained and registered a revenue case on the application preferred by respondents No. 1 to 6 for recording their names in respect of the suit land and the matter was reserved for orders on 20.05.2026.

Learned State Counsel submits that as per the entries available on the online portal, no final order has been passed by the Tehsildar as he was on mass leave and the matter is now fixed for 04.06.2026.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and

circumstances of the case, it is directed that the Tehsildar, Pathariya, District Mungeli, shall not pass any final order in Revenue Case No. 202604250900002/A-6/2025-2026 until the next date of hearing.

List this case on **10.08.2026**.
