2. The present Cr.MP under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:-

“It is, therefore, prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be kind enough in allowing the present petition and to quash the F.I.R. dated 18.10.2018, registered by the police of police station Durg (C.G.). (ANNEXURE P/1) as PuraniBhilai, Durg, District abuse of process of laws.

Any other relief as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit may also be granted in favour of the petitioner, in the interest of justice.”

4. In view of the submissions made by the learned State counsel, the present Cr.MP is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to law, if aggrieved by outcome of the closure report, if so advised.
