31/07/2026	Mr. Vivek Sharma, Advocate General assisted by Mr. Avinash Singh GA for the petitioner/State. None for the respondents. Mr. Sharma, learned Advocate General, submits that the matter has been assigned to Mr. R.K. Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, to argue on behalf of the State however, Mr. Gupta was available during the first half of the day but owing to some personal exigency, he had to leave the Court in the second half and, therefore, prays for a pass over of the matter. A perusal of the record reveals that the present petitions have remained pending since the year 2015 where the State itself is the petitioner. It is further evident that on 30.01.2026, at the request of the learned counsel for the

suguna	petitioner-State, the matter was adjourned. Again, on 20.03.2026, the matter was adjourned on the request of the petitioner-State. Even today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, a request for pass over has been made on behalf of the petitioner-State. Although this Court was inclined to hear the matter, in the absence of the learned counsel entrusted with advancing arguments on behalf of the State, the matter could not be taken up. This Court cannot be oblivious to the fact that the petition has remained pending for more than a decade. However, considering the request made by the learned Advocate General, one further opportunity is granted. It is made clear that if, on the next date of hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner-State is not in a position to advance arguments, this Court shall proceed to decide the petitions on the basis of the material available on record without granting any further adjournment.
