It is ordered that the appellant shall communicate this order to the respondents forthwith. It is also clarified that the Mediation Centre shall issue notice to all respondents to ensure that they have an opportunity to participate in the mediation process. The Mediation Centre shall proceed only after satisfying itself that proper notice has been served upon all parties in accordance with law.

Registry is directed to communicate a copy of this order to the Mediation Centre for compliance.

List this case on **15/04/2026** along with the mediation report.

Accordingly, **I.A. No. 02/2026 is disposed off.**
