1. The present appeal under Section 14-A(1) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (in short

“the SC/ST Act”) has been preferred by the appellant against the order dated 01.07.2024 by which charges have been framed, application under Section 227 CrPC has been rejected and criminal proceeding has been initiated against the appellant in connection with Crime No.423/2023 registered at PS Supela, District Durg (CG) for offence under Sections 294, 506 Part-II, 323, 325, 376(2)(n), 313 of IPC and 3(2)(v-a) of SC/ST Act.

2. Learned counsel appearing for appellant seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the appeal.
