19/11/2019	Shri Shakti Raj Sinha, counsel for the appellants. Shri Aditya Sharma, PL for the State. Heard on IA No.1/2019, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail. The appellants have allegedly committed murder of the deceased Chhatrapal during the period 5 pm to 6 am on 19/20.10.2018. Three witnesses namely, PW-4 Santosh Khare, PW-5 Ramdular Lathiya and PW-14 Somdev Garhewal have seen quarrel between the deceased and the appellants near Mangal Bhawan of the village at about 5 pm and since thereafter the deceased was not seen in the company of any other person. These witnesses did not disclose to the Police about the last seen together incident for about 5 days. The injury found on the body of the deceased is in the nature of stab wound and incised wound, whereas the Police has recovered stone, iron rod and iron pipe from the appellants. Considering the nature and quality of evidence available on record, we are inclined to suspend the sentence and release the appellants on bail. Accordingly, IA No.1/2019 is allowed. Execution of substantive jail sentence imposed upon the appellants shall remain suspended during the pendency of this appeal and they are directed to be

released on bail provided they furnish a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- each with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the trial Court for their appearance before the Registry of this Court on 20.01.2020 and thereafter they shall continue to appear before the trial Court on all such subsequent dates as are given to them by the said Court, till the disposal of this appeal.
