Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Additional Registrar by letter dated 6/07/2019 has directed to the respondent No.3 to hold an enquiry and even in such direction finding has been given that the petitioner is guilty of misconduct. It is contended that said finding has been arrived without giving any opportunity of hearing or initiating departmental enquiry against the petitioner and if higher authorities has given such finding there is no option to the respondent No.3 to hold otherwise than guilty, therefore annexure P-1 may be stayed. Shri Manish Upadhyay, learned counsel appears for respondent No.3 on advance copy and would submit that bank has no option except to obey the orders of the Registrar. In view of such submission, till reply is filed on record by the State, it is directed that effect and operation of order dated 6/07/2019 shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.
