Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the Chhattisgarh State Electricity Regulatory Commission has passed the order in absence of the petitioner and certain observations were made against the petitioner in view of the application submitted by Chhattisgarh Power Limited. The Chhattisgarh Power Distribution Company Ltd being aggrieved with the order has also preferred an appeal which has also upheld the order in view of the certain observations made by the Electricity Regulatory Commission. The Chhattisgarh Power Distribution Company Ltd. has issued the demand notice. On the basis of this factual matrix when this Court put a specific query whether the commission has review the power whether the petitioner exhausted the remedy or review which is permissible to them under the Electricity Act, 2003. The petitioner would submit that he may be given a week's time to examine this issue. As prayed, post this matter on 20th of July, 2023.
