Horilal Yadav **Versus** State Of Chhattisgarh & Others

24.11.2020	Mr. Awadh Tripathi, counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Mateen Siddiqui, Dy. AG for the State. Learned Dy. AG prays for short adjournment to file reply to the writ petition. Heard on I.A. No.1 which is an application for grant of interim relief. Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the advertisement the petitioner had submitted all the documents required for the said post and respondent authorities after having scrutinized the documents and credentials of the petitioner have initially granted full marks to the petitioner for his experience and had placed the petitioner on the top in the order of merit. However, subsequently after reviewing the case of the petitioner they have reduced the marks so far as his experience is concerned on the ground that he would not be entitled for any marks for the experience that he has received as a Lab Technician. Counsel for the petitioner referring to the advertisement submits that as per the advertisement the requirement is only having served in any of the institutions in the Health Department of the Government of Chhattisgarh. There is no distinction that the experience should be only as a M.P.W. or for that matter any other specific post. In view of the said contentions as stated by the counsel for the petitioner and as is reflected from the advertisement enclosed along with the writ petition, as an interim measure respondents are directed to permit the petitioner to participate in
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the counselling and he be counseled accordingly. However, order of appointment in case if the petitioner is found suitable, be not issued till the writ petition is decided.

Respondents also should ensure that one post against the post for which the petitioner had applied should be kept vacant till the next date of hearing.
