AWARD

(Passed on 09.05.2026)

1. By the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the reduction of salary from Rs. 20900/- per month to Rs. 20,000/- per month and sought continuation of salary at the rate of Rs. 20900/-.
2. However, the petitioner, appearing through video conferencing, along with learned counsel, submitted that he is now receiving the

salary as per the government directions and, therefore, he did not wish to press the petition.

3. In view of the submission made by the parties, the writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
4. The Court also recorded that the contesting parties had amicably settled the dispute and, finding the terms of compromise to be just, proper, and legal, accepted the settlement arrived at between them.
5. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
