10/07/2026	Heard Shri Gagan Tiwari, Adv. for the petitioner, Ms Anuja Sharma, Dy. Govt. Adv. for the State and Ms Priyanka Rai, Adv. for the respondents No.4 & 5. In the present petition, the petitioner is challenging the order dated 5.2.2026 passed by the respondent No.3 by which the permission granted to the petitioner vide order dated 3.2.2026 for pursuing two year diploma in Animal Husbandry (DAH) course at Veterinary Polytechnic College, Mahasamund, has been withdrawn by referring the order of this Court passed in WPS Nos.1138, 1135 & 1100 of 2026 wherein it is stated that guidelines have been framed about qualification, experience and percentage of employees for promotion of class IV employees. According to the learned counsel, once the order permitting to pursue the Diploma Course as an in-service candidate has

	been passed the same cannot be withdrawn by referring the order of this Court where some guidelines have been framed. The order impugned has not stated anything by which the High Court has restricted or prohibited for grant of permission to in-service candidates to pursue two year diploma in Animal Husbandry (DAH) course. Learned counsel for the State, <i>ex adverso</i>, would submit that the order impugned has been passed in pursuance to the order passed in pending writ petitions where the State has stated that some policy will be framed in respect of promotion to class IV employees. According to the learned counsel some of the writ petitions have been withdrawn. Issue notice to the respondents. Ms Anuja Sharma, Dy. Govt. Adv. would accept notice on behalf of the State/respondents No.1 to 3 and Ms. Priyanka Rai, Adv. would accept notice on behalf of the respondents No.4 & 5. The respondents are granted four weeks time to file reply. In view of the above, process fee need not be paid. <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> This is an application for grant of interim relief. Issue notice on this application also, as above. Having considered the entire facts situation of the case and particularly considering the fact that the permission granted to the petitioner to pursue two year diploma in Animal Husbandary (DAH) course has been withdrawn by referring some order of this Court whereas the order impugned reflects

Gowri	that the Court has only directed to frame some policy with regard to promotion of class IV employees and there is no order restricting or prohibiting grant of permission to in-service candidates to pursue the aforesaid diploma course, purely an interim measure, it is directed that the effect and operation of the order dated 5.2.2026 and the letter dated 9.2.2026, both in respect of the petitioner, shall remain stayed, till the next date of hearing. However, it is made clear that the petitioner's whose permission has been withdrawn, if he is otherwise entitled for admission as per Regulation 7.03 of the Chhattisgarh Kamdhenu Vishwavidyalaya Lower Education Academic Regulations, 2014, his candidature be considered and he be permitted to pursue two year diploma in Animal Husbandary (DAH) course in the current academic session.
