16/07/2026	Mr. Pravesh Sahu on behalf of Mr. P. R. Patankar, counsel for the appellant. Heard on I.A. No.02/2026, for condonation of delay in filing the appeal. The accident occurred on 30.06.2023. Learned Tribunal passed the award in favour of the claimants on 22.11.2025. The present appeal was filed on 06.07.2026. However, the claimants have not received any amount under the said award to date and the present appeal has been preferred by the Insurance Company with a delay of 127 days. Upon due consideration, I.A. No. 02 is allowed and the delay of 127 days in filing the appeal stands condoned, subject to the appellant paying costs of ₹30,000/- by way of cheque in favour of any one of the claimants before the Tribunal within a period of 15 days from today.

Khatai	Heard on admission. Admit. Call for the records. Let notice be issued to the respondents by ordinary as well as speed post. Process Fee shall be paid within a period of seven working days. Also heard on I.A. No.01/2026, for grant of stay. The Tribunal has passed an award of ₹20,74,880/- in favour of the claimants/respondents No.1 to 4, which has been challenged by the Insurance Company in this appeal. It is directed that subject to the appellant/insurance company depositing 60% of the awarded amount within a period of 30 days from today, execution of the remaining portion of the impugned award shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing. The claimants shall be entitled to withdraw the amount to be deposited by the appellant Company upon furnishing an undertaking to return the same whenever the Court directs. The appellant shall place on record the receipts regarding payment of the aforesaid costs and the deposit of 60% of the awarded amount by the next date of hearing. Sd/- (Sanjay Kumar Jaiswal) JUDGE
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
