Also heard on I.A. No.01/2026, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail.

By the impugned judgment dated 24.03.2026 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Durg, District- Durg (C.G.) in Sessions Trial No. 258/2024, the appellant stands convicted and sentenced as under:

Conviction	Sentence
Under Section 118(2) read with Section 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023	RI for 3 years and fine of Rs.1,000/-, in default of payment of fine, additional RI for 6 months
Under Section 351(2) of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023	RI for 1 years
Both the sentences were directed to run concurrently	

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, further considering that the co-accused- Sanju Yadav @ Shubham has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 11.05.2026 passed in CRA No. 1199/2026, that the appellant has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for three years and has already remained in custody for more than one year and ten months, and that the disposal of this appeal is likely to take some time, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I am of the opinion that the present is a fit case to suspend the jail sentence imposed upon the appellant and to release him on bail.

Accordingly, the application (I.A. No. 01/2026) is allowed. It is directed that the substantive jail sentence

<i>Priyanka</i>	imposed upon the appellant shall remain suspended till final disposal of this case on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court for his appearance before the Registry of this Court on 29.07.2026. He shall thereafter appear before the concerned trial Court on a date to be given by the Registry of this Court and thereafter, continue to appear before the concerned trial Court on all such subsequent dates as are given to him by the said Court till disposal of this appeal. List this case for final hearing along with CRA No.1199/2026 in its due course. Sd/- (Radhakishan Agrawal) Judge
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
