Issue notice to Respondents No. 6 and 7 as per rules. Notice to other Respondents stands dispensed with as they are represented by the State Counsel. Also heard on I.A. No. 1/2019, for grant of interim relief. Considering the orders passed in two writ petitions earlier filed by the Petitioner, that is, the order dated 21.7.2008 (Annexure P-3) passed in WPS No. 3881/2008 which got decided on the same date and the order passed on 1.9.2017 in WPS No. 4387/2017 and also the order dated 17.1.2018 on which date the said writ petition got disposed of, also taking into consideration the



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resolution dated 12.10.2017 passed by the General Administration Committee of Janpad Panchayat, Saja, prima facie, a strong case for grant of interim relief is made out.
