11/02/2026	Heard Ms. Priya Mishra, Advocate along with Ms. Swati Verma, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. S.S. Baghel learned Government Advocate, appearing for the respondent No.1/State in above cases and Mr. Ravi Kumar Banjare, learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nos.2 to 4 in CRMP No. 1131/2021 and CRMP No. 1113/2021 as well as Mr. Suresh Kumar Verma, learned counsel, appearing for the respondent Nos. 2 to 4 in CRMP No. 204 of 2023. On the last date of hearing, this Court had directed the concerned Superintendent of Police to ensure service of notice upon respondent Nos. 2 to 4 in Cr.M.P. No. 1131/2021 and Cr.M.P. No. 1113/2021, who were directed to appear before this Court on the next date



fixed.

Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, Mr. S.S. Baghel informs this Court that notice has been duly served upon respondent Nos. 2 to 4 in the aforesaid Cr.M.Ps. The concerned Superintendent of Police has also filed an affidavit regarding service of notice.

On a pointed query made by this Court to Mr. Ravi Kumar Banjare, learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos. 2 to 4 in aforesaid Cr. M.Ps., as to whether he has filed the Vakalatnama/Power, he submitted that he has already filed a memo of appearance. Upon a further query as to whether he intends to file a reply, he prayed for time to file the same.

Prayer is **allowed**.

Two weeks' time is granted to the learned counsel for respondent Nos. 2 to 4 in the aforesaid Cr.M.Ps. to file their return. Thereafter, one week's time is granted to the learned counsel for the petitioners to file rejoinder.

List the case thereafter.

In the meanwhile, the names of Mr. Rajkumar Gupta and Mr. Krishna Gupta, as shown in the cause list as counsel for the respondents, shall be deleted. In their place, only the name of Mr. Ravi Kumar Banjare shall be



reflected in the cause list as counsel for the respondents.

Interim order, if any, shall continue till the next date of hearing.
