

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****SA No. 420 of 2023****NARAYAN SURYAVANSHI *versus* RATIRAM SURYAVANSHI****Order Sheet**

16.03.2026	Shri Deepak Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the appellants. Shri Divyanand Patel, learned counsel for the respondent No. 1. Shri Anand Gupta, learned counsel for the respondent No. 15. Heard on I.A. No. 02/2023, an application for deletion of the name of respondent No. 13(A).

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the LRs of respondent No. 13(A) are already on record and, therefore, he may be permitted to delete the name of respondent No. 13(A) from the array of parties.

I.A. No. 02/2023 is allowed.

Learned counsel for the appellant further submits that on 11.08.2025, notices were issued in I.A. No. 03/2023 (an application under Order XXII Rule 4 CPC read with Order VI Rule 17 CPC) and I.A. No. 04/2025 (an application under Section 125 of the High Court of Chhattisgarh Rules, 2007 read with Order XXII Rule 9 CPC) to respondent No. 3. However, notices to the LRs of respondent No. 12 could not be issued inadvertently.

As per the office report, the notices issued to

the LRs of respondent No. 3 have been duly served upon them. However, since no notice has been issued to the LRs of respondent No. 12, fresh notices are required to be issued to them.

Accordingly, issue notice to the LRs of respondent No. 12, namely Ram Narayan, on payment of process fee within a period of seven days.

In the meantime, the appellant shall carry out the necessary amendment in the cause title pursuant to the order passed in I.A. No. 02/2023 within a period of seven days.

List this appeal after three weeks.
