Mr.T.K.Jha, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, would submit that the petitioner is married daughter of the deceased Government servant, who died in harness and she being dependant is entitled for compassionate appointment, but her claim has not been considered on the ground that other married daughter Nutan Sahu is already in Government service without holding any enquiry as to whether any financial assistance is being provided by Nutan Sahu to the petitioner or not. He would rely upon the judgment of this Court passed in the matter of <u>Ku.Jaishree v. State of Chhattisgarh and others</u> (WPS No.4438/2021), decided on 25.8.2021. The writ petition being arguable is admitted for hearing. Issue notice to the respondents. Mr.Aditya Sharma, learned Panel Lawyer, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
