No. 1 for suspension of sentence and grant of bail under Section 389 of the Criminal Procedure. The appellants stands convicted under Section 147 of IPC to undergo SI for one year and fine of Rs. 500/- in default of imprisonment for 15 days, under Section 186 of IPC to undergo SI for three months and fine of Rs. 500/-, in default of payment of fine imprisonment for 15 days, under Section 294 of IPC to undergo SI for three months and fine of Rs. 500/- in default of fine imprisonment for 15 days, under Section 353 of IPC to undergo SI for two years and fine of Rs. 1000/- in default of payment of fine	



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imprisonment for one month, under Section 332 of IPC to undergo SI for two years and fine of Rs.1000/- in default imprisonment for one month.

Having heard the counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the short period of sentence, this Court is of the opinion that it is a fit case, in which substantive jail sentence imposed on the appellants can be suspended and they can be enlarged on bail. Accordingly, I.A. No. 1 is allowed.

It is directed that substantive jail sentence imposed on the accused/appellants shall remain suspended during pendency of this criminal appeal and they shall be released on bail on their furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the trial Court for their appearance before the Registry on **06th September, 2016** and thereafter before the concerned trial Court on a date to be fixed by the Registry and thereafter on all such subsequent dates as would be given by that Court till final disposal of this appeal.
