Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-PSC would submit that in the examination under dispute, examination of various subjects were taken by the PSC, but the documents to be complied with order dated 22.09.2025 with regard to all the subjects are difficult to collect, though
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search is going on. He further submits that if order dated 22.09.2025 would confine to the subjects only pertaining to the bunch of writ petitions, then order dated 22.09.2025 may be complied with.

Counsel appearing for the petitioners and other counsel for the respondents have not raised objection on aforesaid contention made by the learned counsel for the respondent-PSC.

Since, dispute pertains to the subjects only to which respondents appeared in the said examination.

Hence, having considered the contention of counsel for both the parties, learned counsel for the respondent-PSC is directed to comply with the order dated 22.09.2025 only to candidates/parties of this bunch of petitions whom were marked as 'Not-Eligible'('NE').

Aforesaid order be complied with within three weeks.

List these cases in the **week commencing 12th January, 2026.**

Interim relief granted earlier shall continue till next date of hearing.
