1. The petitioners have filed this petition seeking the following relief(s):-



“10(i) That, this Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondents authorities to consider and grant promotion to the petitioners prior to date of promotion of respondents no. 6 and 7 as they are much their juniors with all consequential benefit, in the interest of justice.

10(ii) That, this Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to quash the promotion orders (Annexure P-1) of the respondents no. 6 and 7 on the post of Sub Inspector and the petitioners may be considered for promotion on the post of Sub Inspector from the date of their juniors has been granted promotion, in the interest of justice.

10(iii) Any other relief which may be suitable in the facts and circumstances of the case, may also be granted.”

2. It appears that the petitioners have challenged the order of promotion of respondents No. 6 and 7 from the post of Assistant Sub Inspector to the post of Sub Inspector dated 22.07.2021.
3. Mr. Anway Tiwari, learned Panel Lawyer appearing for respondents No. 1 to 5/State would submit that the order of promotion passed in favour of respondents No. 6 and 7 has already been cancelled vide order dated 05.01.2022.
4. Heard learned Panel Lawyer for the State.
5. Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioners have challenged the order of promotion passed in favour of respondents No. 6 and 7 and same has been cancelled by the respondent authorities vide order dated 05.01.2022, therefore, nothing survives for adjudication. Accordingly, the petition is **dismissed**.
