HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR**TPC No. 143 of 2026**Lakshmi Alias Dhriti Luniya **Versus** Tanmay Luniya**Order Sheet**

09/09/2026	Heard Mr. Rajendra Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Ms. Juhi Jaiswal Acharya, learned counsel for the respondent. Ms. Acharya submits that she has instructions for appearing on behalf of the respondent, and she seeks to be granted a week's time for filing the Vakalatnama to oppose the matter on behalf of the respondent. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent has filed an application under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, registered as Civil Suit No. 11A/2026, before the Family Court, Mahasamund, District – Mahasamund (C.G.). He submits that the petitioner is a resident of District – Durg (C.G.), which is

about 100 Kilometres away from Mahasamund, and, therefore, she may face difficulty in regularly attending the hearings before the Family Court, Mahasamund. Accordingly, it is prayed that an interim order may be granted in her favour.

Ms. Acharya opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and contends that there is no good ground for granting any interim order.

Considering the submissions advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is a resident of District – Durg (C.G.), which is about 100 Kilometres away from Mahasamund, and that she may face difficulty in regularly attending the hearings before the Family Court, Mahasamund, it is directed that further proceedings in Civil Suit No. 11A/2026, pending before the Family Court, Mahasamund, District – Mahasamund (C.G.), shall remain stayed.
