29/11/2021	Shri Ajay Shrivastava, Counsel for the Petitioner. Ms. Priyamwada Singh, Dy. G.A. for the State. Heard on admission and also on I.A. No. 01 i.e. application for grant of interim relief. It is submitted that the petitioner had earlier obtained permit No. 720/B/2019 from RTA, Bilaspur for plying buses from Raigarh to Jashpur. Later on to ply the buses in different districts, he filed application for counter signature as required under Section 88 of the Motor Vehicle Act. In the subsequent development by the notification dated 24.12.2019, the RTA Raipur has been constituted a Single Regional Transport Authority for the whole state, therefore requirement for counter signature has been dispensed with. Hence, the petition is admitted and interim relief is granted. Learned State counsel opposes the argument and prays time to file reply. As prayed, time is granted for filing reply. In the meanwhile, it is directed that petitioner shall have the



liberty to operate the buses on the basis of earlier per

mentioned hereinabove untill the next date of hearing.
