1. Heard.

2. The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking following reliefs :-

“(i) That, this Hon’ble Court may kindly be



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pleased to quash the impugned order dated 17.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) and petitioner may be allowed to continue to operate the vehicle without insisting on the counter signature, in the interest of justice.

(ii) Any other relief which may be suitable in the facts and circumstances of the case, may also be granted.”

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, since the petitioner has sold the vehicle, the present petition has become infructuous.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
5. Interim order dated 29.11.2021 issued in favour of the petitioner is recalled.
