Shri Ravi Bhagat, learned Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the State, hence, PF is not required to be paid to these respondents. On payment of PF as per rules, issue notice to respondent-4. Notice be made returnable within three weeks. Also heard on IA-01 of 2022, application for grant of interim relief.



Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that petitioner is holding the post of Accountant and posted at Block Education Officer, Bakawand by virtue of impugned order Annexure P1 he was transferred to Higher Secondary School, Dodrepal, Bakawand on administrative ground. In the transfer place of posting of petitioner, no post of Accountant is in the set up. Hence, order impugned, so far it relates to petitioner, is wrong.

Learned counsel for the State seeks time to file reply to petition as well as for grant of interim relief also. However, on instructions, he does not dispute submission of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Considering facts and circumstances of the case, submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, it is directed that impugned order of transfer dated 10.09.2022, so far as it relates to the petitioner, shall remain in abeyance till the next date of hearing.
